Dear guests of our "Third International Meeting Days", Dear responsible parties of the quest groups,

Our "Third International Meeting Days" will begin soon and we are really looking forward to this time of speaking together, praying and celebrating.

We would like to use this letter to inform you of the current status of our event, request information from you about your group and ask you for two contributions for our meeting days.

1. Information on the current status of the "Third International Meeting" Days"

Guests and accommodation / meals:

- 130 young people from 11 European States will be present.
- Nearly all guests will be able to stay in private homes.
- All guests will be fed by us. Breakfast will be provided by the host families, lunches and dinners will be provided by our parishes.

Contribution to costs:

We will subsidize the travel costs of all guest groups at least 50%; but probably more.

Motto and program:

The motto of these days is a verse from Psalm 18: "And by my God have I leaped over a wall". Thirty years after the division of Europe into East and West we want to see which walls need to be overcome today and what tasks Christians need to fulfill to accomplish this.

- We hope we have created an exciting and diverse program. The program will consist of daily joint liturgy, joint activities to explore Frankfurt, political discussions on the topic of "Europe", a Pontifical High Mass with the Bishop of Limburg and a big party at the end.

Arrival and departure:

- Your groups shall **arrive** on **Wednesday, September 18.** We will be expecting you all day in our "reception office" at the Church of St. Hedwig. You will receive a warm welcome and be fed there. You will also meet your host family there. The address is:

What is needed?

2. What information do we need from you?

- The exact number of guests from your guest group (participants and chaperones)
- The age and gender of the guests.

- The type of travel (bus / car / flight / train).
- Your approximate arrival time.
